Where is the Youth Science Summit located? Jeffersonville High School, 2315 Allison Lane, Jeffersonville, IN 47130

How to register for the Youth Science Summit? Registration is available online at KYScienceCenter.org or by calling 502-561-6100.

Are there multiple days of the Youth Science Summit? Which Youth Science Summit should I attend?

No, the 2017 Clark Country Youth Science Summit is a singular full-day experience; however the Science Center is offering various Youth Science Summits at other locations throughout the region – visit KYScienceCenter.org for details. All Youth Science Summits will provide a quality experience with region-specific partners for the lab offerings, discussion groups and information sessions, but there may be some duplicate content if your student has attended Summits previously in Louisville or Lexington. Of particular interest to this event are fields represented by Southern Indiana industries and career opportunities: Advanced Manufacturing, BioMed, Information Technology, and Logistics.

Is participation limited to students of Greater Clark County Schools?

No, youth from throughout the region in Indiana and Kentucky are welcome to participate!

Which track should I sign my student up for?

Students 10-18 currently in Middle School or High School are eligible to participate in the Summit. Content will be provided by a variety of community partners, researchers, professionals, etc. and all presenters have been instructed to prepare content for an accelerated & enthusiastic audience. Youth Science Summits are also social experiences. We encourage Middle school aged students, even ones that may have skipped grades, to sign up for tracks with their similarly aged peers.

Will food be provided?

Yes a light breakfast and lunch will be provided for student participants.

Are parents allowed to attend?

No. Parents are encouraged to help students prepare and sign permission forms to ensure students get checked-in properly. Can students leave program early?

No, full day participation is crucial for the optimum experience and students will receive their t-shirts at the end of the program.

What do students need to bring?

Students should bring completed Health and Permission Forms, closed toe shoes, and enthusiastic attitudes.

Where to park?

Ample parking is available at Jeffersonville High School. Signage and volunteers will be on hand to guide you to the check-in station.

What time should we arrive for check-in?

Participants can arrive anytime between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM,
