EVENT DETAILS

DATE: Friday, January 24, 2020

LOCATION: Ivy Tech, Sellersburg: 8204 County Rd 311, Sellersburg, IN 47172

HOURS: High School: arrival 8-8:30, event 8:30-1:00, departure 1:00-1:30

PARKING: Ample parking is available at Ivy Tech. All school vehicles that arrive will be directed to parking upon student drop-off.

CHECK-IN: Check-in will take place upon arrival.

Teachers do NOT need HEALTH AND PERMISSION FORMs for each student since this information is on file with the schools. ***Individual students will not be admitted to the Youth Science Summit without turning in the completed Health & Permission Form at check-in.***

Participants will receive a nametag at check-in. Name tags must be worn for the duration of the day for access to the Youth Science Summit.

DROP-OFF: 8204 County Rd 311, Sellersburg, IN 47172. Look for special signage and volunteers at the bus circle for drop off.

Note: almost all Summit Participants will be transported by school sanctioned vehicles, so the following check-out and pick-up details are for individuals only:

CHECK-OUT: Parents and Guardians may sign a waiver allowing high school aged students to transport themselves to and from the event; however, all student participants must stop by the check-out location prior to leaving for the day to sign-out.

PICK-UP: The Youth Science Summit officially ends at 1:00 pm.

MEALS: Lunch will be provided for all participants. A vegetarian option is available, but all other dietary restrictions are the responsibility of the participant.

ATTIRE: Causal dress code. Closed toed shoes are **strongly recommended** for participation in the labs.
